SCHOOL BOARD VOTING METHOD

As the elected officials responsible for the governance of Marion School District 60-3, the board sets the direction for the school district through the establishment of policies and by taking other official actions.

It is the intent of the board that motions be carried by a majority of members elect. In the event that board members are absent or that board members must abstain from voting due to conflict of interest, board action may be taken only if it is approved by the majority of members which, on a board of five (5) members would be three (3) members.

Votes on all motions and resolutions will be by "aye" or "yes" and "nay" or "no." No secret ballots will be used as a voting method.

At the discretion of the president or on the request of a member, a show of hand vote will be made and the vote of members will be recorded. Any board member may request a roll call vote.
