GIFTS AND DONATIONS TO SCHOOLS

All gifts and donations being sent directly to the schools may be accepted provided that the use of the donation is left to the discretion of the school administration. All gifts and donations received shall be consistent and supportive of the district’s vision, mission, and approved programs. Such gifts shall not conflict with any provisions of the School Board policy, state regulations, or public law. Gifts from individuals, groups, or organizations shall be presented to the School Board for a formal acceptance.

Such gifts shall become the sole property of the Marion School District 60-3 and shall not create any program which the School Board would be unwilling to continue when the gift or grant funds are exhausted. Acceptance of any gift or donation shall not imply endorsement of any business or product. The School Board is under no obligation to replace the gift if it is destroyed or wears out.

Any school initiating a fund raising activity that would result in shared costs, installation, or maintenance costs by the school district must be approved by the building principal, Business Manager, and the Superintendent in advance of the fundraising project. The fund raising project must be in compliance with board policy DDJJA.
