STUDENT POLICIES & REGULATIONS	

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

Children of school age who are residents of Marion School District 60-3 may attend school without payment of tuition.

Children who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet all of the following requirements:

- The child resides with his/her parents or legal guardian within the boundaries of Marion School District 60-3;
- The child is in the United States under a visa other than a visitor's visa or a student visa and;
- The child is a participant in a foreign student exchange program approved by the Superintendent.

Marion School District also runs a fully funded pre-school for students who reside within the district boundaries. Eligible students must turn four by September 1 of that academic school year. Parents are required to give a copy of the student's birth certificate and immunization records prior to enrollment. Admission to the pre-school program may be limited at the discretion of the Administration, with respect to class size or student educational requirements.

The School Board has legal authority to determine which school a student will attend. Generally, students will be required to attend school in the attendance area in which they reside, unless special permission has been granted at the discretion of the Superintendent. The residence of the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) will determine the legal address.
