STUDENT POLICIES & REGULATIONS	

USE OF TOBACCO AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS

The School Board recognizes that the use of tobacco products represents a health hazard to the student. The School Board supports and approves a health curriculum that encourages students to be tobacco free. Establishment of a healthy life style is paramount to the mission of the school district. Due to the Board's concerns about maintaining a tobacco free work place, the use of tobacco products shall be forbidden on all school properties, in all school vehicles, and at all school events. The rules and prohibitions apply to students regardless of age and regardless of whether they may legally use tobacco or tobacco products.

All students are prohibited from smoking or using tobacco or tobacco products in school buildings, at school activities, or on school property; students are prohibited from possessing tobacco or tobacco products in school buildings, at school activities, and on school property.

Penalties for violating this policy include referral to legal authorities, and other penalties as outlined in the regulations for this policy.
